When any dental procedure is being performed, it is important to know that the degree of periodontal disease is often best assessed when the pet is under anesthesia. At this time, diseased teeth are often found which could require extraction. Please check the box below to authorize the extraction of diseased teeth.

- Extract the tooth or teeth and do any dental procedures necessary that would most benefit my pet's health. I understand that my bill will be adjusted accordingly. Minor teeth extractions range from \$15-40 and major teeth extractions range from \$70 and up.
- Call me at the telephone number given to the receptionist for approval of any procedure or extraction not previously discussed with me or included in my dental estimate. If I cannot be reached, I understand that my pet will be awakened and a second anesthesia and dental may need to be scheduled.
- Do not do any procedures beyond what has already been estimated and approved by me.

I have been advised as to the nature of the procedure or surgery described above and the risks involved. I authorize the use of appropriate anesthetics and medications that are needed to perform these procedures or surgeries. I realize that results cannot be guaranteed, I further realize that I am responsible for full payment at time of discharge. I understand that unforeseen conditions may extend the procedure or surgery and that if this happens, the AHR staff will try to contact me to discuss these conditions. If I cannot be reached, I consent to having Animal Hospital of Rowlett and Diagnostic Center take the steps necessary to help ensure the safe care of my pet.

Comfort and Safety Options

Anesthesia carries some risk (even though it may be small). AHR's doctors and staff utilize safe anesthetic protocols for all of our patients. Some patients, due to age or pre-existing conditions will have already received an estimate that includes lab work, ecg, IV fluids, laser use, or Duragesic[®] pain patch. These are provided as options for patients and their owners, if not previously required by your doctor.

- yes no Presurgical health Screen (this test is required for all patients over 5 years of age) . . . \$63.60
- BUN, creat, ALT, ALKP, Glucose, t.p. hematocrit (will screen for pre-existing liver or kidney problems, anemia, high or low blood sugar)
- electrocardiogram (screen heart rate and rhythm)

- yes no Laser surgery (reduces blood loss, swelling and postoperative pain) \$38.00-\$160

- yes no AVID chip (tiny mircochip that contains a personal one-of-a-kind identification number, injected under the skin between the shoulders). \$38.00

- yes no Ora-Vet[®] application and 1 take home kit with 8 cartridges (reduces plaque and tartar formation by preventing bacteria from attaching to your pet's teeth). \$49.55

- yes no Dental Radiographs - full mouth. \$75.00
